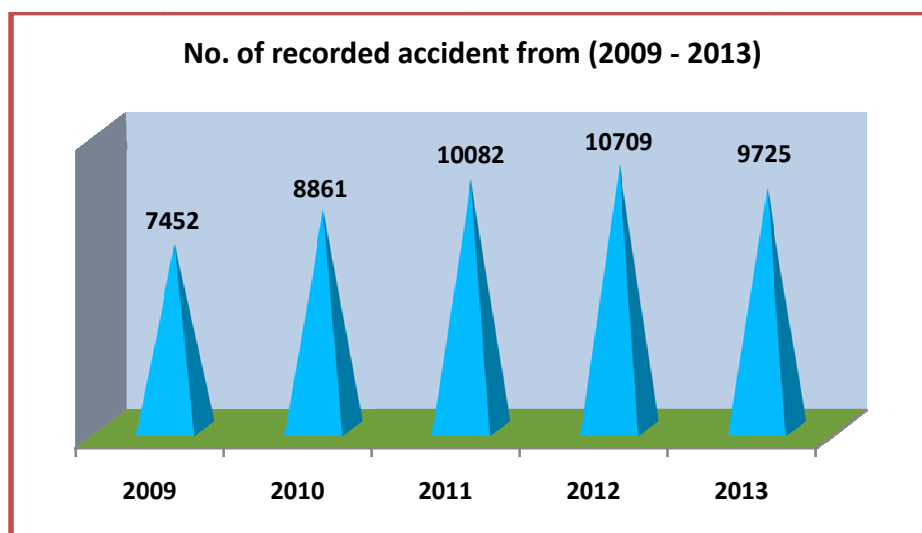

Statistic of traffic accident recorded for 2013

- Decrease in the number of recorded traffic accidents for the year 2013 at 9.2%
Statistic of recorded traffic accidents in 2013
- The number of recorded traffic accidents reached (9725) accidents during 2013, including (2601) fatal accidents at a rate (26.7%) and non-fatal (7124) accidents at a rate (73.3%) of all governorates except for the Kurdistan region, compared to (10709) accidents in 2012 with a decrease at a rate (9.2%).

Decrease in the number of traffic fatalities (deaths) and injuries from last year and by (94.2%)

The number of victims of traffic accidents for the year 2013 (deaths) by sex (2951) people, including (2330) males at a rate (79.0%) and (621) females at a rate (21.0%) of the total number of

deaths Recording a "decrease of (94.2%) compared to last year where the number of victims of traffic accidents for the year 2012 (deaths) (3132)

As for the injured of traffic accidents for the year 2013 amounted to (10694) recording "rate of decline of (2.9%) for the year 2012 where it was (11009) injured.

Crashes among the rest of the accidents is the highest percentage recorded during the year 2013 by (47.0%)

- the highest rate of crashes recorded during 2013, reaching (4568) accident at rate (47.0%) of the total accidents, followed by run-over car accidents (3793) accident at rate (39.0%) and rollover accidents (1288) accident (13.2%) and the other (76) accident at rate (0.8%).

The highest number of traffic accidents was in October and at rate of (9.6%)

- Recording the number of recorded traffic accidents by months, in October (937) accident was recorded and at rate of (9.6%), followed by September (890) accident at rate (9.2%), the rest of the months (7898) accident at rate (81.2%) of the total accidents that amounted (9725) accident during the year 2013.
 - recorded the number of accidents according to the type of road (9725) accident during the year, including on the main road (4880) accident with rate (50.2%) and on the subroad (2362) accident at rate (24.3%) and on the highway (1951) accident at rate (20.0%) and on the rural road (532) accident at rate (5.5%) of the total number of accident.

The highest rate of traffic accidents due to the drivers have been recorded at rate (67.1%)

- The results showed that one of the causes of accidents were caused by driver where recorded (6527) accident at rate (67.1%) and represents the highest rate, and because of the car (1414) accident with rate (14.6%), and because of pedestrians (772) accident rate (7.9%) either the rest of the reasons was (1012) accident rate (10.4%) of the total number of accidents and amounted (9725) accident during the year 2013.
